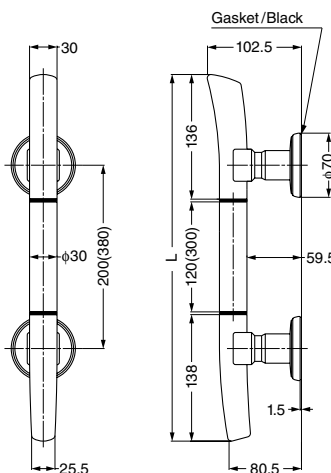

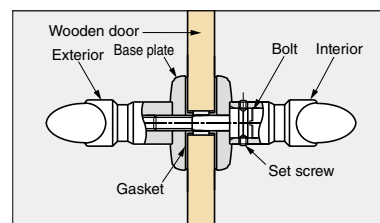
Features

The series emulates "Ryusui" flowing water Japanese design and has gentle soft lines, providing a comforting and desirable aesthetic.
- The Tamazusa series has knobs, handles and lever handles.
- This door handle is covered in 24k gold plating.

Tamazusa is a range of handles inspired by the art and architecture of the Momoyama period in Japanese history.

When the 16th overlord Nobunaga Oda set about the bloody process of unifying Japan he built a fabulous castle near Kyoto. Until the Momoyama period Castles were gloomy military structures but Azuchi castle was a glittering celebration of power and art. The intention was to impress and intimidate and the fusion of art and architecture defined the era.
